

# HOW TO TREAT BEE BOXES

## BEE BOXES

The following information was given to me by the South Eastern Texas Bee Keepers with our PCO Choice. They just got back from Las Vegas giving a seminar on PCO Choice and Bee Hives.

### **Protocol using PCO Choice for insects on and around Bee's:**

Using a paint brush and PCO Choice at 4 ounces concentrate to 1 gallon water

- 1) Paint inside super structure
- 2) Inside top lid
- 3) All inside frames

This process will not affect the bees, the bee's wax nor will it affect the honey.

However it will neutralize and repel any mites, varroa mites & beetles.

Spray around bee boxes to prevent ants as well as other insects from making nest.

### **Protocol using Cedar Shield for up-keep of Bee Boxes:**

#### **ONE-TIME, LIFETIME-APPLICATION**

On outside of older or existing boxes sand off white paint and apply Cedar Shield Wood Penetrant. This will protect the wood from numerous issues such as moisture can no longer enter the wood media, no cracking, splitting, rot, mildew, mold or fungi.

On new boxes prior to building spray or paint entire box on the outside, two applications are required.

(Wet on wet) DO NOT LET DRY BEFORE ADDING SECOND COAT.

This will protect the wood from numerous issues such as moisture can no longer enter the wood media, no cracking, splitting, no rot, mildew, mold or fungi
